We connect WA people and products to the rest of the country and the world. Safely connecting and contributing to Western Australian communities is what we do, and we're in it for the long haul.

Our teams based in the greater Perth area are central to this commitment. They are responsible for the maintenance and upgrade of 318 kilometres of track and infrastructure including signalling and communications. In addition, our team of network controllers at our Midland Control Centre work 24/7 to ensure the safe and efficient operation of trains across our network.

At our training centre in Kewdale, and head office in Perth, we have teams who work to ensure the safe and efficient operation of our rail freight network.

Together the metro teams play a vital role in delivering products from the eastern states to WA, and local products to Fremantle Port for export to global markets.

Since Arc Infrastructure was awarded the long-term lease of the railway in 2000, we've invested almost \$250 million into our infrastructure throughout the Perth region.

Our commitment to the greater Perth region extends far beyond investment into our infrastructure. We contribute to the economic growth and development of the region by employing local people, engaging with industry, buying from local business, working in partnership with our customers, supporting community initiatives and protecting the environment.

We want to make a real difference. That's why we partner with community organisations to achieve meaningful outcomes. On average, Arc Infrastructure makes a direct contribution of more than half a million dollars to WA each year in the form of community partnerships, cash and in-kind donations and volunteering hours.

Arc Infrastructure is a Foundation Partner of the Constable Care Child Safety Foundation's Safety School.

Aimed at children from 4-11 years, the school is modelled on Perth's streets, including model heritage buildings, a working rail platform, pedestrian and level crossings, and traffic lights and intersections.

Our teams volunteered over 720 hours to source, design and install rail and signalling equipment to create a scaled down version of a functioning level crossing.

We are committed to putting rail safety on the agenda for educators across WA, and our partnership with Constable Care and the Safety School extends this commitment to school students across the State.



The Constable Care Safety School provides children with a hands on opportunity to learn vital pedestrian, bike and public transport travel safety skills.
